## **RESOLUTION 2023-71**

## FY2024 Rebuild Alabama Transportation Plan for the City of Troy, Alabama

WHEREAS, the Alabama Legislature enacted Act 2019-2 known as the Rebuild Alabama Act; and

WHEREAS, the Rebuild Alabama Act requires that the monies paid to a municipality pursuant to Section 7 of this Act be deposited into a separate fund maintained by the municipality and expended only for certain approved expenditures as detailed in the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Rebuild Alabama Act requires that the municipal governing body of each qualified municipality adopt an annual Transportation Plan providing a detailed list of projects for which expenditures are intended to be made in the next fiscal year from the fund which shall be based upon an estimate of the revenues anticipated from the fund; and

WHEREAS, it has been estimated that the City of Troy may receive an estimated \$135,501.00 distribution in fiscal year 2024 of motor fuel taxes from the Rebuild Alabama Act; and

WHEREAS, the Troy City Council has reviewed the FY2024 Rebuild Alabama Transportation Plan, as attached hereto, for the City of Troy, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that this Transportation Plan is for projects for which multiple years of the revenues anticipated from the fund are required to support; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Troy, Alabama that the *FY2024 Rebuild Alabama Transportation Plan for the City of Troy, Alabama*, as attached hereto, is hereby adopted.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Troy, Alabama that the approved plan be posted as required by the Act.
