

Remarks: Mockingbird Lane is a two-year RATP project (FY2020 & FY2021).

Mockingbird Lane was bid in 2019 and is being constructed in conjunction with the Kimber IA Project (IAR-055-000-012) and Kimber ST Project (ST-055-999-007-CN) to improve safety and accessibility to and from an educational site and available commercial spaces.

In addition to City funding, the Kimber IA & ST project is being funded by Industrial Access and State Public Road and Bridge Funding through the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) and was bid, is being constructed, and is governed by ALDOT standards associated with IA & ST funding.

Any remaining funds at FY2021 year end will be held and utilized for the next approved RATP project.
