RESOLUTION 2019- 69

FY2020 Rebuild Alabama Transportation Plan  
for the City of Troy, Alabama

WHEREAS, the Alabama Legislature enacted Act 2019-2 known as the Rebuild Alabama Act; and

WHEREAS, the Rebuild Alabama Act requires that the monies paid to a municipality pursuant to Section 7 of this Act be deposited into a separate fund maintained by the municipality and expended only for certain approved expenditures as detailed in the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Rebuild Alabama Act requires that the municipal governing body of each qualified municipality adopt an annual Transportation Plan providing a detailed list of projects for which expenditures are intended to be made in the next fiscal year from the fund which shall be based upon an estimate of the revenues anticipated from the fund; and

WHEREAS, it has been provided that the City of Troy may receive an estimated \$81,300 distribution in the first year of motor fuel taxes from the Rebuild Alabama Act; and

WHEREAS, the Troy City Council has reviewed the FY2020 Rebuild Alabama Transportation Plan, as attached hereto, for the City of Troy, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that this Transportation Plan is for a project for which expenditures are intended to be made in the next fiscal year some of which are from the fund which is solely based upon an estimate of the revenues anticipated from the fund; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Troy, Alabama that the *FY2020 Rebuild Alabama Transportation Plan for the City of Troy, Alabama*, as attached hereto, is hereby adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Troy, Alabama that the approved plan be posted as required by the Act.
