

RESOLUTION 605

ESTABLISHING A PREFERENCE ZONE FOR BIDDING

WHEREAS, the Alabama Legislature has established procedures for procuring labor, services, work, or for the purchase of materials, equipment, supplies, or other personal property involving the expenditure of funds greater than that established in §41-16-50; and

WHEREAS, prior to advertising for bids for the aforementioned items the awarding authority may establish a local preference zone; and


WHEREAS, the local preference zone clause provides that in the event a bid is received for an item of personal property to be purchased or contracted for from a person, firm, or corporation deemed to be a responsible bidder, having a place of business within the local preference zone of the municipality, and the bid is no more than three percent greater than the bid of the lowest responsible bidder, the awarding authority may award the contract to the resident responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the city council of the City of Troy wishes to establish a preference zone as authorized for the purchase of the aforementioned items; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, that:


- (1) for all purchases of labor, services, work, or for the purchase of materials, equipment, supplies, or other personal property involving expenditures of amounts exceeding the threshold established by the state legislature, the corporate limits of the City of Troy shall be the preference zone.
- (2) any department requesting bids for the aforementioned items involving expenditures exceeding the established threshold, shall indicate within the requests for bids that the local preference zone is the corporate limits of the City of Troy.
