The following schedule is being provided for the City of Troy's residential garbage customers, who the City of Troy picks up garbage and recycling each week. The included days are upcoming set holidays that the City of Troy offices are closed. Emergency services such as police and fire protection will stay fully operational during these holidays.

Thursday's Garbage & Recycling Routes will be picked up on Friday, January 2, 2026

Martin Luther King Jr. Day – Monday, January 19, 2026

Monday's Garbage & Recycling Routes will be picked up on Wednesday, January 21, 2026

President's Day/John Lewis' Birthday – Monday, February 16, 2026

Monday's Garbage & Recycling Routes will be picked up on Wednesday, February 18, 2026

Memorial Day – Monday, May 25, 2026

Monday's Garbage & Recycling Routes will be picked up on Wednesday, May 27, 2026

Juneteenth – Friday, June 19, 2026

Friday's Garbage & Recycling Routes will be picked up on Thursday, June 18, 2026

Independence Day (observed) – Friday, July 3, 2026

Friday's Garbage & Recycling Routes will be picked up on Thursday, July 2, 2026

Labor Day – Monday, September 7, 2026

Monday's Garbage & Recycling Routes will be picked up on Wednesday, September 9, 2026

Veterans' Day – Wednesday, November 11, 2026

Wednesday's Garbage & Recycling Routes will be picked up on Thursday, November 12, 2026

Thanksgiving Holidays – Thursday, November 26, 2026 and Friday, November 27, 2026

Thursday's Garbage & Recycling Routes will be picked up on Wednesday, November 25, 2026

Friday's Garbage & Recycling Routes will be picked up on Monday, November 30, 2026

Christmas Holidays – Thursday, December 24, 2026 and Friday, December 25, 2026

Friday's Garbage & Recycling Routes will be picked up on Monday, December 28, 2026

Special Clean-Up Months by District

District 1—January/June

District 3—March/August

District 5—May/October

District 2—February/July

District 4—April/September

During special clean-ups, residents of single-family dwellings within that district are given the opportunity to dispose of furniture, appliances, junk autos, large bulky items, etc. without being assessed the standard special pick-up fee normally charged for oversized loads. Residents who wish to take advantage of this service can put items out on the day of their regular garbage pick-up or by contacting 311 or (334) 566-0177 to schedule a special pick-up during their special clean-up month.
