Special Clean-Up Months by District

District 1—January/June District 3—March/August District 5—May/October

During special clean-ups, residents of single-family dwellings within that district are given the opportunity to dispose of furniture, appliances, junk autos, large bulky items, etc. without being assessed the standard special pick-up fee normally charged for oversized loads.
