Alcoholic Beverage Application Process

Alcoholic Beverage Control Licenses (ABC) are approved by the City Council of the City of Troy, as well as the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (ABC) of the State of Alabama.

* Before an ABC license application can be made with the City of Troy, the applicant must first apply to the State of Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board Licensing & Compliance Division located at 107 Commerce Drive, Enterprise, AL 36330. The phone number is (334) 792-9155. Or by going to their website at <http://alabcboard.gov/licensing-compliance/how-to-apply>.

*Once application is made with ABC, a copy of the application must be given to the City Clerk. Upon receipt of appropriate application, the City Clerk's Office will review all of the information provided, and copies will be provided to the Building Official for compliance with codes, the Fire Inspector for compliance with codes, the Police Chief, for an interview, local background check and a canvass of the local area in which the alcohol will be sold, and other state or county agencies as required for issuance of licenses (i.e. health inspection, etc.). Results will be given back to the City Clerk's Office, and the applicant. If any problems are noted by the Departments and/or other agencies, it is up to the applicant to make all corrections before the application process can continue. Each department and/or agency shall sign off that all corrections have been completed prior to submitting final applications to the council.

* All final applications will be placed upon the next available meeting. The City Clerk's office will notify the applicant of the meeting date. The council meets at City Hall on the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month at 5 p.m. The applicant or a representative is required to attend.

* Upon approval of the application a letter will be sent to the State ABC Board and the City's Licensing Department, at which time the State license and City license may be purchased.

* It will be necessary to purchase additional City of Troy business licenses as required. The type of licenses or licenses that must be purchased will be determined based on the type of business being conducted.
